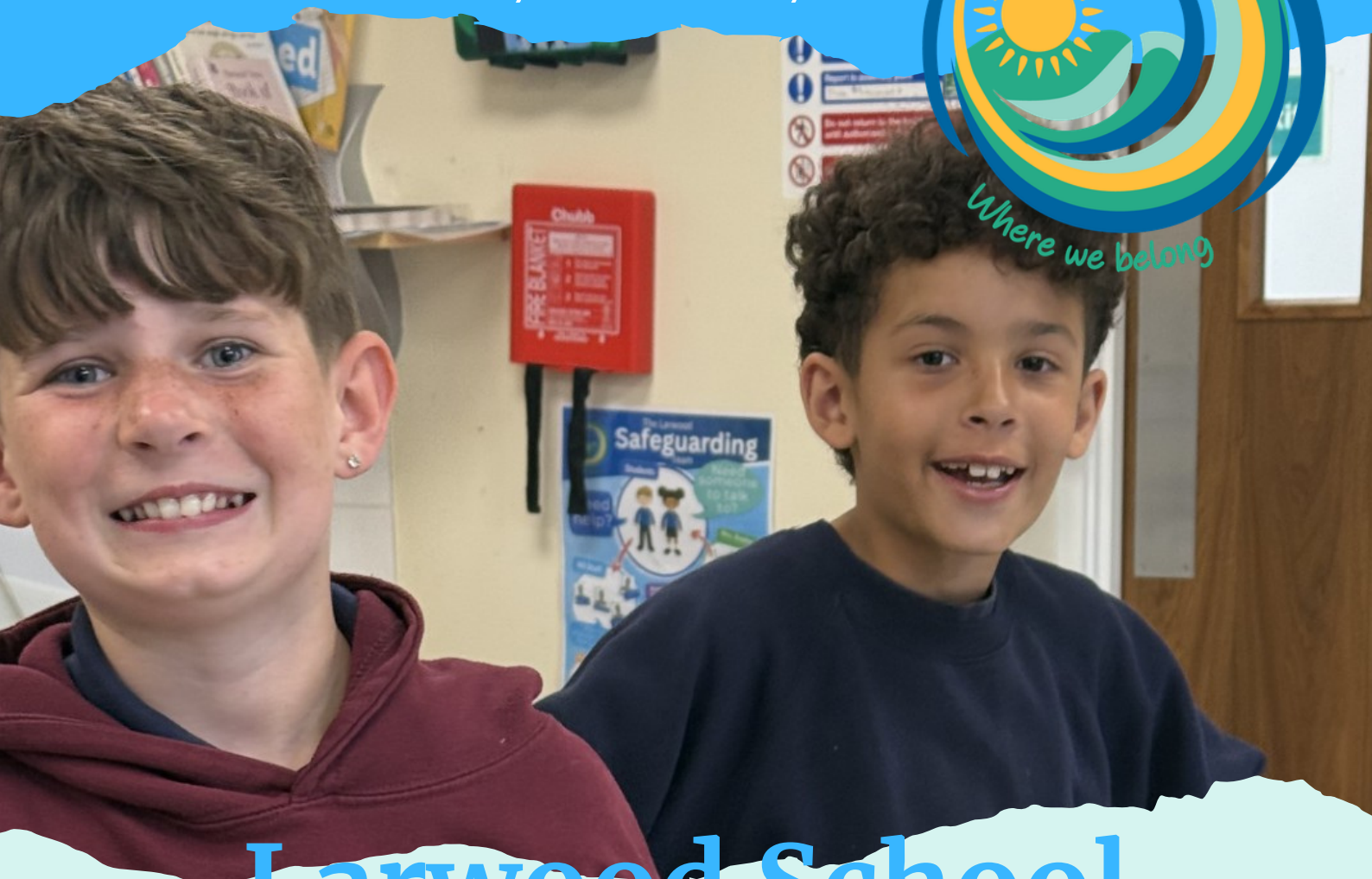

Online Safety Update

The UK government plans to require smartphone makers to block children from taking, sharing, or viewing nude images by default. Companies have three months to comply or face legal action. The measure aims to reduce online exploitation, grooming, and exposure to harmful sexual content while protecting children's wellbeing. For parents and carers, this is a useful opportunity to remind their children about what is appropriate to share online.
